

BALTIMORE CONVENTION CENTER FIRE DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS

1. All curtains, drapes, signs, banners, acoustical materials, plastic cloth, and decorations must be constructed of fire resistive materials, and a certificate of flammability must be provided upon request of the Fire Prevention Officer.
2. No combustible materials, merchandise or signs shall be attached to, hung, or draped over fire resistive side and/or rear divider of booths, or attached to table skirting facing aisles unless fire resistive.
3. All exits, hallways and aisles leading from the building are to be kept clear and unobstructed at all times. No curtains, drapes or decorations shall be hung in such a manner as to cover any exit signs. There shall be no obstruction blocking exit door from outside the building, such as autos parked in doorways or barricades across sidewalks.
4. No exit door shall be locked, bolted or otherwise fastened or obstructed at any time the building is open to the public.
5. All sawdust and shavings shall be locked, bolted or otherwise fastened or obstructed at any time the building is open to the public.
6. Automobiles, trucks, tractors, machinery, and other motor vehicles utilizing flammable fuels, which are placed on display inside the building, shall have no more than five (5) gallons of fuel in the tank; all fuel tanks shall be locked off, effectively sealed and battery cables disconnected from the ignition system. Ignition keys for vehicles on display shall be kept by a responsible person at the display location for removal of such vehicles from the building in the event of emergency.
7. No Flammable liquids or liquefied petroleum gases shall be used or admitted inside the building. Cylinders or compressed gases shall be secured in a vertical or horizontal position, depending on tank use and design, pending written approval by the Fire Prevention Officer.
8. All electrical wiring shall be installed in a manner approved by the City Chief Electrical Inspector.
9. All standpipe, hose cabinets, and pull box stations shall be kept clear and unobstructed at all times.
10. Carpet drapes, curtains, scenery and all other materials used for artistic enhancement in display must be flame proofed.
